The campaign focuses on brain health awareness and priority policy asks, such as the creation of an European Parliament Intergroup on Brain Health and Research and supporting the creation of EU and National Brain plans, in line with ongoing advocacy work such as the <u>Pledge for Science</u>, <u>Global Call to Action</u> and <u>2024 EU Elections Manifesto</u>.

### **Evaluation of the Erasmus E-Care4PD Project**

A few days ago we received the response of the closing of the e-Care4PD project, which involved partners such as the Parkinson Madrid Association (Project Coordinator), Serbian Brain Council, EPIONI (Greece) and the Belgian Brain Council, the report included a detailed evaluation of the project by the Spanish Service for the Internationalization of Education (SEPIE). This evaluation was based on the final report and the documentation submitted to justify the overall development of the project. The project obtained a score of 92 out of 100, standing out for its relevance and the impact achieved in the community of people with Parkinson's disease and their caregivers.
